



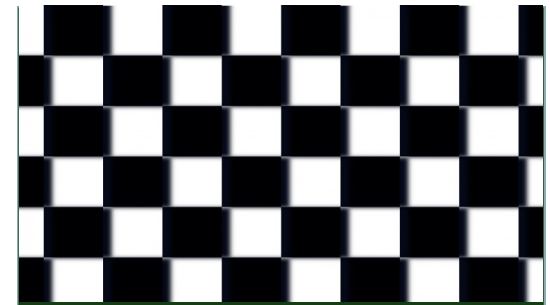

Race will begin and end at Hamilton Ice Arena, 2501 Lincoln Park Dr. Columbus, IN 47201.

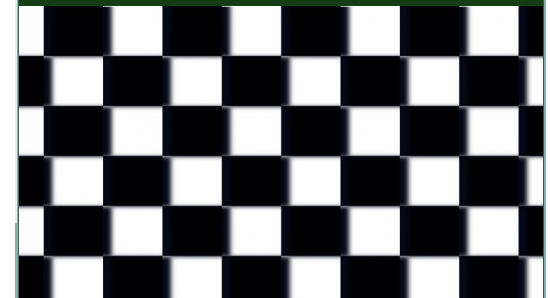
