



Invasive Plant Removal Tool Share Program Now Available!

The Clark County Harmful Invasives Removal Project (CCHIRP) has created a “bucketful” of resources to help homeowners remove invasive plant species from their properties.



Each bucket kit includes dabbers, a handsaw, loppers, spray bottle for herbicide mixing (herbicide not included), safety glasses, and disposable gloves. A Calendar of Control (yours to keep!) is also included that details best method of control, herbicide recommendation and application rates, and best season for control.



Anyone in Clark County is eligible to borrow a bucket! Contact the Clark County Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) office at 812-256-2330, ext. 3, to reserve your bucket. Once checked out, buckets need to be returned clean.
